General principles and requirements:

- The programme is aimed at unemployed graduates who have successfully completed at least a three (3)-year Degree/ National Diploma **OR** students who have passed all course work but require practical workplace exposure for completion of a qualification in any field specified above.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have obtained a minimum 60% aggregate pass mark at undergraduate level and a minimum 55% pass mark at post graduate level.
- Applicants are only opened to South African citizens between the ages of 18 and 35 years.
- Students that still need to finish or qualify for a Degree or National Diploma should not apply.
- Applicants who have benefited from an Internship programme and have previous formal employment in the field of study will not be considered.
- GEPF will not make provision for transport and or accommodation to any candidate attending the interviews or appointed candidate.
- GEPF will ensure that its selection and recruitment process is employment equity compliant. Preference will be given to people with disabilities
