Helping you to claim your benefits

The Government Employees Pension Fund (GEPF) is concerned with the increase in the number of unclaimed benefits due to the failure to locate former GEPF members or their beneficiaries who have not claimed their benefits upon their exit from the Fund.

The GEPF considers an unclaimed benefit as any claim that has not being paid to either a member, pensioner or beneficiaries within a period of 24 months. Often benefits remain unclaimed because of:

- Claims with uncorrected errors over a period of 24 months
- Contributions from a member having ceased without any indication that a member has exited the fund
- Beneficiaries not claiming benefits following the death of a member
- Untraceable members due to incorrect contact details or information not being updated
- Suspected fraudulent claims
- Members not claiming benefits following the conclusion of their unsuccessful dismissal appeal process
