UPDATE YOUR GEPF BENEFICIARIES INFORMATION

A nomination form is an official document that decides who should receive your GEPF pension benefits pay out when you pass on.

NB: A Will does not serve as a nomination form.

All you need to do is:

- Complete a nomination of beneficiaries form (WP1002). Obtainable from your Human Resources section or on the **GEPF** website
- · List the details of all your financial dependents and anyone you want to nominate to share in your benefit and what percentage they should receive
- State clearly whether any of your nominees have disabilitiesSubmit the filled WP1002 form, along with your supporting documents such as; ID copies and birth certificates to your Human Resources section
- A newly completed nomination form cancels out the previous one

You may amend your nomination form if you feel that is necessary and you should do this every time your dependents change due to birth, death, divorce etc.
