4.	Certified copy of the marriage certificate, lobolla letter, proof of marriage according to religious tenet, proof of life partnership approval by GEPF or Life partner application.	Attached Missing
5.	Where the member / deceased member had a previous marriage, a copy of the divorce decree or death certificate of the previous spouse. Where there are multiple spouses, copies of the proof of traditional marriages, or according to religious tenet.	Attached Missing
6.	Duly completed Bank Particulars Form (Z894) for each applicant.	Attached Missing
7.	An originally certified copy of the previous medical scheme Membership Certificate of the deceased member, and new medical scheme Membership Certificate for the spouse that is registered as the main medical scheme member.	Attached Missing
8.	A copy of the Nomination of Beneficiaries Form (WP1002) and / or an originally certified copy of member's / pensioner's last will and testament , where available.	Attached Missing
